

NFHS COACHES EDUCATION UPDATE – MAY 2010

- **Fundamentals of Coaching Softball** is now online and was developed in conjunction with USA/ASA Softball (\$50)
- The **NCAA Eligibility course** is now online. Great for coaches of prospective Division I and II students, counselors, and parents (\$20)
- **“Concussion in Sports – What You Need to Know”** online course will be available by June 1 (no cost to user)
- **Fundamentals of Coaching Cheer and Dance** (July 2010) now in production (\$50)
- **Fundamentals of Coaching Basketball** (September 2010) now in production (\$50)
- **Fundamentals of Coaching Track and Field** to begin development by the summer of 2010 (no projected launch date yet) (\$50)
- **The NFHS is revising the First Aid for Coaches course** to provide coaches much more content on sports injuries. In addition, the NFHS Sports Medicine Advisory Committee is adding an 8th unit into the course to deal with specific interscholastic issues, such as helmet removal
- **NFHS is beginning development of “The Role of the Parent in Interscholastic Sport”** online course to be delivered to parents. It will cover many topics that will educate parents including, the mission and purpose of interscholastic athletics, how to handle difficult situations, how to communicate with the coach etc. We will use students as onscreen hosts for this course rather than adults. The content comes from the Michigan State University Institute for the Study of Youth Sports and is research based. (No cost to the user)
